ONE of a KIND

John 1: 14 So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.15 John testified about him when he shouted to the crowds, "This is the one I was talking about when I said, 'Someone is coming after me who is far greater than I am, for he existed long before me. 16 From his abundance we have all received one gracious blessing after another [grace for grace]. 17 For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. 18 No one has ever seen God. The only begotten Son, who is himself God, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him. [is near to the Father's heart. He has revealed God to us.] (TTV)

This Mission Manuscript:

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him. 18 "There is no judgment against anyone who believes in him. But anyone who does not believe in him has already been judged for not believing in God's one and only Son. 19 And the judgment is based on this fact: God's light came into the world, but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil. 20 All who do evil hate the light and refuse to go near it for fear their sins will be exposed. 21 But those who do what is right come to the light so others can see that they are doing what God wants.



- World- Another common word in John's writings, found 78 times in this Gospel and 24 times in his letters (only 47 times in all of Paul's writings). It can mean universe, the earth, the ppl on earth, most ppl, ppl opposed to God, or the human system opposed to God's purposes. John emphasizes the word by repetition, and moves without explanation from one meaning to another.
- Thus, The Apostle John is the author to a real WorldView!!! A Redemptive, Relational, & Rejoicing!

<u>SAVE - sozo</u> (save, heal, deliver) and now understand **<u>SALVATION - soteria</u>**: Salvation - Soteria: A Greek Word Study

(soteria from soter = Savior in turn from sozo = save, rescue, deliver) describes the rescue or deliverance from danger, destruction and peril.



Salvation is a broader term in Greek than we often think of in English. Other concepts that are inherent in soteria are general and include restoration to a state of safety, soundness, health and well being as well as preservation from danger of destruction.

William Barclay - In classical Greek soteria means 'deliverance' or 'preservation'. It can be used for a man's safe return to his own home or his own country after an absence and a journey. It can mean a 'guarantee of safety' or a 'security against danger'. In the papyri by far the commonest meaning of soteria is 'bodily health'. For instance, a member of the family writes home, 'Write me a letter about your soteria,' or, as we would say, 'Let me know how you are.'

One and only SON-

One and only SON The Greek term used here is monogenes, meaning "one of a kind."

At one time, it was presumed that the term derived from the Greek words monos ("one" or "only") and gennao (to beget"). The translation "only begotten" is based this assumption. Subsequent manuscript discoveries produced evidence that the term actually comes from monos and the noun gene ("kind" or "type"). The term monogenes therefore refers to uniqueness and has no inherent reference to chronology or origin.

Hebrews 11:17 reinforces this by referring to Isaac as the monogenes of Abraham. Isaac was not Abraham's first child—chronologically. Ishmael came first. But Isaac was considered unique because of the Supernatural intervention that aided in his birth and his role as the son through whom God's covenant with Abraham continued.
