1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage. 6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love. 7 You were running the race so well. Who has held you back from following the truth? 8 It certainly isn't God, for he is the one who called you to freedom. 13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. 14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. 17 The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants. And the Spirit gives us desires that are the opposite of what the sinful nature desires. These two forces are constantly fighting each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions. 18 But when you are directed by the Spirit, you are not under obligation to the law of Moses.19 When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, 21 envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

Prophecies, (Gk. propheteia Strongs #4394) From pro, "forth," and phemi, "to speak." The primary use of the word is not predictive, in the sense of foretelling, but interpretive, declaring, or forth-telling, the will and counsel of God.

Prophetic is about igniting purpose, hope, and identity through the gift of prophecy. One scriptural passion is in 1 Corinthians 14: – "Earnestly Pursue love and eagerly desire spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy." It is our bcc unique call in the supernatural to see every1one rise up in the prophetic.

This does not leave out practical / pragmatic problem solving members. We all are a part of the body of Christ, and have need of every1one so that every1plays. (The illustrations of: "A Word of Knowledge to someone, chat lines, text lines, \$ to assist, MPAACT to pray & lead into. Salvation, Discipleship Transformation, Testimonies etc. I.E.- clouds in lobby...)

1 Corinthians 12: 12For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. 13For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit. 14For in fact the body is not one member but many.

20But now indeed there are many members, yet one body. 21And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you. 27Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.

31 But earnestly desire and zealously cultivate the greatest and best gifts and graces (the higher gifts and the choicest graces). And yet I will show you a still more excellent way to live that is beyond comparison (a path that transcends)—unselfish love.

1 Corinthians 13:7 Or "Love bears all things." Although commonly understood to mean that love can bear hardships of any kind, the nominalized form of the verb (stego) is actually the word for "roof" found in Mark 2:4. Paul is saying that love covers all things, like a roof covers the house. See 1 Peter 4:8. Love does not focus on what is wrong but will bear with the shortcomings of others. And like a roof protects and shields, you could say that love springs no leak. It is a safe place that offers shelter, not exposure.

A Prophetic Ministry

Prophetic ministry is a much larger thing than the predictive. Perhaps it would be better if we said that the prophetic function, going far beyond mere events, happenings and dates, is the ministry of spiritual interpretation. That phrase will cover the whole ground of that with which we are now concerned. Prophecy is spiritual interpretation. If you think about it for a moment, in the light of prophetic ministry in the Word of God, I am quite sure you will see how true this is. It is the interpretation of everything from a spiritual standpoint; the bringing of the spiritual implications of things, past, present and future, before the people of God, and giving them to understand the significance of things in their spiritual value and meaning. That was and is the essence of prophetic ministry. - WHAT PROPHETIC MINISTRY IS by T Austin Sparks

1 Corinthian's 14:1 It is good that you are enthusiastic and passionate about spiritual gifts, especially prophecy. [a] 2 When someone speaks in tongues, no one understands a word he says, because he's not speaking to people, but to God—he is speaking intimate mysteries in the Spirit.[b] 3 But when someone prophesies, he speaks to encourage people, to build them up, and to bring them comfort.[c] 4 The one who speaks in tongues advances his own spiritual progress,[d] while the one who prophesies builds up the church. 5 I would be delighted if you all spoke in tongues, but I

desire even more that you impart prophetic revelation to others. Greater gain comes through the one who prophesies than the one who speaks in tongues, unless there is interpretation so that it builds up the entire church.

- 1 Corinthians 14:2 This verse makes it clear that the tongues Paul refers to are not known languages but Spirit-inspired utterances.
- 1 Corinthians 14:3 The Greek word paramythia (a hapax legomenon) could also be translated "soothing, calming speech" or "affirmation." Paul does not describe prophecy here as predictive, but as influential to advance the spiritual welfare of the body.

The Blessing (lyrics) by Kari Jobe & Cody Carnes Jesus Christ is Now our High Priest!

The song begins with these words:

The LORD bless you and keep you, make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you, the LORD turn his face toward you and give you peace.

If you've been to a liturgical church you'll recognize these lines that end every service. The practice of sending forth worshippers with this blessing stretches back thousands of years. It comes from Numbers 6:24-27, when the priests are instructed as to how they should proclaim God's blessing over Israel.

It's called the Aaronic or Priestly Blessing and was a regular part of Temple worship in Jerusalem and in synagogues too. The early church inherited this practice from Jewish worship, where it also continues to this day.

The sheer ancientness of this blessing is astonishing. Modern readers will struggle to appreciate these cryptic lines because of their antiquity. But a few insights from language and culture will help us to understand and meditate on them:

The LORD bless you

To bless, is to ask God to look favorably on someone, to bestow some kind of goodness or benefit upon them.

and keep you

The Hebrew verb literally means to "guard," "protect" or "watch over." We find the same verb three times in Psalm 121:7-8, "The LORD will keep you from all harm — he will watch over your life; the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."

make his face shine upon you

This sounds oddly concrete to us, but the concept it communicates is profound. The word panim (face) can also mean "countenance" or "presence." Think of how a person's face "lights up" when they see a loved one. We could translate it, "may God smile at you." It communicates God's affection and pleasure at hearing our prayers.

and be gracious to you

The Hebrew word here, hanun, is the same word "grace" that denotes God's desire to forgive sin and to show favor to the undeserving. It might surprise you if you think grace only comes along in the New Testament! turn his face toward you

Yet another ancient expression that describes God giving his full and complete attention to our prayers, listening deeply to our concerns.

and give you peace

The Hebrew word shalom is broader than our word 'peace' which tends to just mean lack of conflict. Instead, Shalom includes health, safety, prosperity and wholeness. Ultimately, this phrase describes God supplying our physical and material needs as well as our emotional needs.

Putting these ideas together, we find that the Aaronic blessing describes God's loving provision and his watchful, protective gaze over his people. We hear of God's heart for listening to our prayers and his desire to comfort and sustain us in every way. What welcome words to our troubled, anxious hearts during the Coronavirus pandemic!

The biblical text emphasizes that these words of blessing had no human author. They were not penned by an ancient psalmist or by a prophet. God himself is their originator, and he alone can fulfill them. When God instructed priests to speak them over Israel, he was making it clear that they were acting as mouthpieces, human voices to proclaim his loving intentions. God is the one who activates these words in the lives of listeners, to do for them what they cannot do for themselves.

This changes how I listen to this song and watch the video. To me it's not about the Church being alive in spite of the lockdown, or the unity it displays. It's not even about how the Church has blessed hundreds of thousands through concrete acts of kindness. Through this video, I think it is the Lord himself using the voice of the UK Church to express his incredible love for the world.

And through Christ, our "Amen" (which means "Yes") ascends to God for his glory.
