- we are the Heart of God in our world, so we start with JESUS. God Is Love and sent HIS SON for us to receive HIS LOVE. We now Love HIM and Live & Give HIS Love to others in this world.
- From our start to next step is to be Holy Spirit Led.
  - JESUS modeled what it is like to Live a Spirit-Filled Life on earth. (Philippians 2: 6-7) Jesus did not minister the miracles, signs, and wonders from HIMSELF being only The Son of God, but from HIM also being the Son of Man-fully human as we.
  - How did Jesus Move in Great Power? HE received the Holy Spirit upon Him and The Spirit remained. John 1: 29-34.
  - Jesus was Anointed by The Holy Spirit becoming the Christ, Messiah, Anointed One, and Led to HELP ppl in broken, bound, and breathless situations Isaiah 61:1-4, 6 is what Jesus speaks and announces from in Luke 4:17-22a.
- This is for us as sons and daughters of God, who are servants that are human just like Him. We are to do greater works than HE did by the same reliance and resource HE received from The Holy Spirit. We grow to know The Holy Spirit through an abiding Relationship.

We must cast off the temptation of thinking academic achievement, working to earn or deserve, or following formulas or concrete instructions will grow us in God or closer to Christ. Our aptitude is based upon having an ongoing affectionate Relationship with The Holy Spirit Who Is intangible and invisible which scripture calls spiritual and eternal. We want God and His Goodness in our lives by genuinely knowing through a Relationship with the Person of The Holy Spirit.

- I. Holy Spirit known
- A. Allegory Story of AnaMaria and I trying to get to know each other for a possible relationship. Almost not coming together because of misleading or false information.
- B. John 14: 12-13, 16-18, 23, 26
- C. BLB writes- To many people, the Holy Spirit is an enigma. Some see Him as an impersonal force or influence, some deny His very existence, and others are not certain who or what the Holy Spirit is. However, the Bible is very clear on this matter; the Holy Spirit is a person, the Third Person of the Holy Trinity.



- D. The Definition of Person— By "person," we mean one who has their own identity or individuality as a rational being. They are conscious of their own existence. When we say that the Holy Spirit is a person some assume that He has eyes, feet, and hands. But these are not the marks of a person. The marks of a genuine person are intelligent knowledge, feelings, and will.
- E. The Holy Spirit Is a Person that can be observed in six ways.
  - 1. He has the characteristics of a person.
  - 2. He acts like a person.
  - 3. He is treated as a person.
  - 4. He has the ministry of a person.
  - 5. He is mentioned in connection with other persons.
  - 6. He is the Third Person of the Trinity, and therefore, is personal.
- II. Holy Spirit Baptized
- A. Baptized in The Holy Spirit is preached by John The Baptist who baptized in water for repentance, remission of sins, and as the forerunner for Jesus to Come. Throughout the NT this subsequent experience uses the phrases of Baptism of The Holy Spirit, Filled with the Sprit, or Spirit Filled, and/or Receiving The Holy Spirit.
- B. Praying &/or Speaking in tongues is not and can not be the goal.

C. John 1: 29-34; Matthew 3: 11



- III. Holy Spirit Anointed
- A. Anointed means consecrating Jesus to the Messianic office, and furnishing him with the necessary powers for its administration; through the idea of contact; to smear or rub with oil, i.e.-touch with the hand;
- B. The Anointing is what makes whatever is being done for God to be better than what we can do in our natural ability and efforts because The Holy Spirit is doing the work to make it good.



- C. Isaiah 61: 1-4, 6; Luke 4: 17-22a Acts 10:38
- D. The Holy Spirit is in me, and lives in us, and I know HIM for my sake. But HE, The Holy Spirit is

upon me, us, as HE was upon Jesus for others sake! The Anointing is upon us for Action, Acts, and to Impact the impossible. The Anointing is to change lives by the supernatural manifesting in measurable way by miracles, signs, wonders, and /or any means Jesus Encounters lives by The Father's Love.

- IV. Holy Spirit Led
- A. The word led is a present-passive verb, indicating that we should continuously surrender and yield ourselves to the desires of the Spirit, Our surrender to the Spirit's leading is an act of the will, a choice we must make; it is saying yes to the Spirit's leading to influence, direct, and empower us, we can overcome uncertainty and misleading.
